Official "Toulouse-Lautrec Poster Contest" Rules

PARTICIPATION IN THE TOULOUSE-LAUTREC POSTER CONTEST IS LIMITED TO RESIDENTS OF THE UNITED STATES WHO ARE PHYSICALLY PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES AT THE TIME OF ENTRY AND WHO MEET THE OTHER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH BELOW.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

Participation constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these rules. The Contest commences at 10 a.m. Eastern Standard Time on February 4, 2017, and ends at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on March 13, 2017 (the "Promotion Period"). The Contest is administered by The Phillips Collection, Washington, D.C.

(1) Eligibility: The Contest is offered and open only to natural persons, age 18 and older as of the date of entry, and who are legal residents of the United States of America for the duration of the Contest and who are physically present in the United States at the time of entry. Employees, independent contractors, officers, and directors, vendors and legal advisors of The Phillips Collection, and the immediate family members and persons living in the same household of such persons, are not eligible to participate in the Contest. Void where prohibited by law. Offer not valid in Arizona, Florida, New York or Rhode Island. At The Phillips Collection's discretion, it may ask for proof that award of any prize is permissible in the apparent winner's jurisdiction of residence and if The Phillips Collection, in its sole discretion, believes that a prize may not be permissible, it may make the award to an alternate entrant chosen in the same manner who appears to be eligible.

Follow instructions on the contest tab to enter by sharing an original poster design inspired by the Toulouse-Lautrec Illustrates the Belle Époque exhibition. Each entrant will be required to provide their complete name, zip code, and e-mail address. There is no limit to entries per participant. **To be eligible, entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on March 13, 2017.** All required information must be completed to enter and to be eligible to win. Incomplete entries will be disqualified. Online entries must be made by the entrant only at the Contest Page. Entries made by any other individual or any entity, and/or originating at any other website or e-mail address, including, but not limited to, commercial contest subscription notification and/or entering service sites, will be declared invalid and disqualified for this Contest. The use of automated entry devices is prohibited, and no mechanically reproduced entries are allowed; all such entries are void. All entries will become the exclusive property of The Phillips Collection and will not be acknowledged or returned. By participating, you consent to The Phillips Collection obtaining, using, and transferring your name, address, and other information for the purpose of administering this Contest.

Ownership and Use. By participating in the Contest, you represent that you are the owner of the design being submitted, are making a submission of a design already in the public domain or are making your submission with express consent of the owner, that you have obtained all third party releases and permissions necessary for our use, in accordance with the license you grant below, and nothing you submit will infringe on the rights of others. You retain all of your ownership rights in the material you submit. However, you grant The Phillips Collection a royalty-free, worldwide, perpetual license to display your image, in whole or in part, without further review or participation from you, in any medium now existing or subsequently developed, in promotional or trade uses .

Internet Limitations of Liability: The Phillips Collection reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to (1) cancel, terminate, suspend, and/or modify the Contest, or any part of it, at any time, without notice, and (2) to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest in whole or in part, at any time, without notice and award prizes using eligible entries received as of the termination/suspension date, if any infection, computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other cause beyond The Phillips Collection's control, affects the integrity or proper conduct of the Contest. The Phillips Collection reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process (if applicable) or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or any other promotion or in a disruptive manner. Any potential winner may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder.

- Your poster printed and displayed at Phillips after 5 on April 6, 2017, and distributed to the first 300 attendees
- Your poster custom framed by Framebridge and displayed at Phillips after 5 on April 6
- A \$150 gift certificate to Pyramid Atlantic Art Center
- A Dual/Family Membership to The Phillips Collection

Odds of winning depend on total number of entries. In order to claim a prize, a winner may be required to complete an affidavit or declaration of eligibility and/or liability and publicity release, which must be signed and returned so that it is received within seven (7) days of date printed on notification or an alternate winner will be selected. If a selected winner is ineligible in any way, the entry will be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected.
