ABSTRACT

Elmer Bischoff Paintings 1947-1985 exhibition records contain material created and collected by The Phillips Collection Curatorial Department, throughout the process of organizing the 1986 exhibition. Included are research and exhibition planning documents.

HISTORICAL NOTE

This exhibition marked the most complete retrospective to date of paintings by Elmer Bischoff.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE COLLECTION

These curatorial records were collected and created during the research, planning and execution of the *Elmer Bischoff Paintings 1947-1985* exhibition. The 35 paintings and 15 drawings displayed in the exhibition highlight a 40 year career that encompassed abstract expressionism, as well as more figural works.

The exhibition opened at The Phillips Collection in Washington D.C. on September 20, 1986 and closed November 2, 1986.

The primary creator of the exhibition planning records was The Phillips Collection Curatorial Department.

The bulk of this collection consists of research. The records include; publicity; articles; invitations; an exhibition schedule; a catalogue; and planning documents.

The collection is owned by The Phillips Collection and was accessioned from the curator's office, in accordance with the museums records schedule.

Processing Notes: After an initial survey of the collection, some documents were identified as being of no future research value for the collection, such as duplicate documents, expense reports, and poor quality photographs. These items were weeded with the librarian's approval. Original newsprint articles were copied onto acid free paper; all documents were re-foldered in acid-free folders and metal paper clips were replaced with plastic clips.
