ABSTRACT

Odilon Redon: Masterpieces from the Woodner Collection records hold material created and collected by Robert Cafritz, former Curator of 19th Century Art, The Phillips Collection, throughout the process of organizing the 1988 exhibition. Included are publicity, articles and reviews.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Phillips Collection was the first east-coast museum to feature *Odilon Redon: Masterpieces from the Woodner Collection.*

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE COLLECTION

These curatorial records were collected and created during the research, planning and execution of the *Odilon Redon: Masterpieces from the Woodner Collection* exhibition. lan Woodner's Redon collection is the largest private holding of the artist's work.

The exhibition opened at The Phillips Collection in Washington, D.C. on April 16, 1988 and closed June 26, 1988.

The primary creator of the exhibition planning records was Robert Cafritz, former Curator of 19th Century Art.

The bulk of this collection consists of research and related material. The records include publicity; reviews, and articles.

The collection is owned by The Phillips Collection and was accessioned from the curator's office in accordance with the museums records schedule.

Processing Notes: After an initial survey of the collection, some documents were identified as being of no future research value for the collection, such as duplicate documents, unrelated research material and expense reports. These items were weeded with the librarian's approval. Original newsprint articles were copied onto acid-free paper, all documents were re-foldered in acid-free folders and metal clips were replaced with plastic clips.
