## **SUNDAY, JUNE 21: ARRIVALS INTO NICE**

Arrivals throughout the day into Nice, with private transfers to Hotel Le Negresco, a historic five-star hotel on the Promenade des Anglais. In the evening, enjoy a private after-hours tour of the Marc Chagall Museum followed by champagne and dinner. | D

## **MONDAY, JUNE 22: NICE AND GRASSE**

Begin the day with an early private tour of the Matisse Museum. Travel to Grasse to visit a private home and art collection, followed by lunch with the collector and local artists. Return to Nice for a special visit to MAMAC, then enjoy dinner at La Petite Maison in the Old Town. | B, L, R

## **TUESDAY, JUNE 23: LE CANNET, SAINT-PAUL DE VENCE & VENCE**

Visit the Bonnard Museum in Le Cannet, then enjoy lunch on the main square. Continue to the Fondation Maeght and visit Matisse's Chapel of the Rosary in Vence. Return to Nice with the evening at leisure. | B, L

## **WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24: NICE TO AIX-EN-PROVENCE VIA LE MUY & CHÂTEAU LA COSTE**

Depart Nice for Le Muy to visit the studio and private collection of Bernar Venet. Enjoy lunch and a tour of the Château La Coste estate, known for its contemporary art and architecture. Arrive in Aix-en-Provence and check in to Villa Saint-Ange; dinner at the hotel. | B, L, D

## **THURSDAY, JUNE 25: AIX-EN-PROVENCE AND BARJAC**

Optional early visit to the lively Aix food market, then tour Cézanne's renovated studio. Travel to Barjac for lunch and an exclusive visit to Anselm Kiefer's Eschaton Foundation at La Ribaute. Return to Aix for an evening at leisure. | B, L

## **FRIDAY, JUNE 26: ARLES AND FAREWELL DINNER**

Visit the LUMA Foundation in Arles, with a Gehry-designed centerpiece and artist residencies. After lunch, take a walking tour of Arles including Roman and medieval sites, and visit the Lee Ufan Foundation. In the evening, enjoy a farewell dinner and art tour at Château Bonisson near Aix. | B, L, D

## **SATURDAY, JUNE 27: DEPARTURES FROM AIX-EN-PROVENCE**

Private transfers arranged to Marseille Airport, Aix TGV station, or Nice Airport depending on individual departure plans. Departures at leisure. | B

## **DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENT**

A deposit of \$4,000 per person is required to confirm your place on the program. The deposit is refundable until October 1, 2025, less a \$500 administrative fee. The balance of payment for the program is due March 23, 2026. If you should have to cancel after October 1, 2025, but prior to March 23, 2026, your deposit would be forfeited. For any cancellations on or after March 23, 2026, your full payment becomes non-refundable. All payments may be made by American Express, VISA, Mastercard, or check.
