CIRCLES TOUR: MARCH 4-8, 2026

This spring's Circles Tour offers an exclusive look into the vibrant art scene of Dallas and Fort Worth with intimate tours, studio visits, and expert guidance from The Phillips Collection's Curator of Modern Art **Clarisse Fava-Piz.**

DAY 1: WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4

Arrive in Dallas by the afternoon and check in at the newly opened, luxurious **Hotel Swexan**. We'll head to the Dallas Museum of Art for a private, after-hours tour of their special exhibition *International Surrealism*. Our evening closes with a welcome reception at the Swexan's exclusive rooftop featuring stunning views of downtown Dallas.

DAY 2: THURSDAY, MARCH 5

We begin the day with a drive through the scenic **Turtle**Creek area en route to the Meadows Museum, home to one of the finest collections of Spanish art outside of Spain.

After our special tour of the Meadows Museum, we'll explore a stunning private collection, before driving to Highland Park Village for lunch and leisure time. In the afternoon, we'll visit The Cedars Union, a creative hub for Dallas artists and makers. For dinner, we'll dine at the iconic Terry Black's Barbecue, the best barbecue within Dallas's city limits.

DAY 3: FRIDAY, MARCH 6

Today, we travel west to Fort Worth for a full day of art and culture. Beginning at the Kimbell Art Museum, we'll experience a private guided tour. Continuing to The Modern Art Museum of Fort Worth, we'll enjoy lunch at Café Modern followed by free time to wander the museum and grounds at leisure. In the afternoon, we will visit the Amon Carter Museum of American Art for a guided tour of their Georgia O'Keeffe exhibition—an exciting glimpse into the Phillips's upcoming Santa Fe trip. After our return to Dallas, the evening is yours!

DAY 4: SATURDAY, MARCH 7

Our first activity brings us to the **Nasher Sculpture Center** for a private tour of their renowned sculpture collection. After lunch on-site at the Nasher, we will explore the **Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Gardens**, a beautiful oasis along White Rock Lake. We'll head back to the hotel to prepare for the evening. Directly before our farewell dinner at the upscale, Italian restaurant Monarch, we will enjoy a private visit to **Samuel Lynne Galleries**.

DAY 5: SUNDAY, MARCH 8

Departures at leisure throughout the day or extend your stay to explore more of Dallas's vibrant art and cultural scene.
