SATURDAY, AUGUST 30: ARRIVALS INTO BARCELONA

Arrive in Barcelona and settle into the Mandarin Oriental Hotel. That afternoon, a walking tour introduces the group to the city's architectural wonders, including Antoni Gaudí's La Pedrera and Casa Batlló. The evening concludes with a relaxed welcome dinner on the hotel's Mimosa Terrace. | D

SUNDAY, AUGUST 31: BARCELONA

The day begins with a private visit to the ornate Palau de la Música Catalana, followed by a guided tour of the Picasso Museum. Guests continue through the Gothic Quarter, visiting the Santa Maria del Mar and the Barcelona Cathedral. The day ends with an exclusive, after-hours reception at the Mies van der Rohe Pavilion. | B, L, R

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 1: BARCELONA

The morning opens with a visit to the awe-inspiring Sagrada Família, followed by a private closing-day tour of the Fundació Joan Miró, including a seated lunch at the Miró Foundation. In the afternoon, guests choose from visits to private collections or cultural institutions. The day concludes with a private dinner at Tragaluz restaurant. | B, L, D

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2: BARCELONA

Guests visit the studio of acclaimed sculptor Jaume Plensa and explore a thought-provoking exhibition at the Museu Tàpies. A light lunch at the museum is followed by a leisurely afternoon and evening to explore Barcelona on your own or unwind at the hotel spa and enjoy the hotel's amenities. | B, L

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3: BARCELONA AND PALMA DE MALLORCA

A short flight brings the group to Palma de Mallorca, where we will enjoy lunch at the Es Baluard Museum of Contemporary Art, followed by a guided tour of the collection. A walking tour of Palma's historic center leads to the majestic Cathedral and Miquel Barceló's striking Chapel of the Holy Sacrament. The day concludes with dinner overlooking the Mediterranean at the Mar Sea Club of the St. Regis Mardavall. | B, L, D

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 4: BINISSALEM AND PALMA DE MALLORCA

The day begins with a visit to the studio of Bernardí Roig, an artist whose work is held in the Phillips's permanent collection, in Binissalem, followed by a wine tasting and lunch at Bodega AVA. Guests then enjoy a private collection visit before returning to the hotel. That evening, Phillips Collection Trustee Beatriz Bolton and her husband Graham host an elegant reception in their Palma home. | B, L, R

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 5: MALLORCA

Guests tour the Fundació Miró Mallorca, comprised of the former home and studios where Miró lived and worked for nearly 30 years. Guests may opt to return to the hotel or continue on to visit the contemporary Gallery Red. The afternoon is free for leisure—whether exploring Palma or enjoying the resort's amenities, including swimming pools, the Arabella spa, or one of the many incredible experiences the hotel has to offer. The trip culminates with a scenic sunset cruise aboard the Barco Royal and a farewell dinner on the terrace of Michelin-starred Es Fum. | B, D

After a final breakfast at the St. Regis, guests depart individually, concluding an extraordinary journey of art, architecture, and cultural connection. | B
