

This summer's Phillips Stateside offers an exclusive look into the vibrant art scene of Santa Fe, including an exploration of the iconic Indian Market, complimented by intimate tours, studio visits, and expert guidance from The Phillips Collection's Vradenburg Director & CEO Jonathan P. DAY 1: TUESDAY, AUGUST 11

Arrive in Santa Fe by 4 pm in the afternoon and check in at the iconic downtown **Hotel Santa Fe**, the only Native American owned hotel in the city. We'll head to the **Georgia O'Keeffe Museum** for a private, after-hours tour. Our evening closes with a **welcome reception** at Trustee Emerita Lynne Horning's home.

DAY 2: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 12

Our day continues with an exploration of **Georgia O'Keeffe's life and practice**. We begin with a visit to her home and studio in Abiquiu, followed by lunch nearby, and a visit to a local **artist's studio**. Then, we'll gather for an enchanting look at **Ghost Ranch**, O'Keeffe's 21,000-acre summer retreat that sparked inspiration for much of her work. After returning to the hotel to refresh, we will enjoy an evening tasting at the **Gruet Tasting Room**, featuring a selection of their acclaimed sparkling wines.

Alternatively, guests may choose to attend the **2026 Annual Benefit and Auction** of the Institute of American Indian Arts (IAIA). *Please note this optional event requires separate arrangements and an additional sponsorship commitment to IAIA.*

DAY 3: THURSDAY, AUGUST 13

We begin the day with an early morning visit to the **New Mexico Museum of Art**, to explore highlights from their collection. Directly following, we'll head to **SITE Santa Fe** for a special tour of their temporary exhibition *Indian Theater: Native Performance, Art, and Self-Determination since 1969*. Following lunch, we will visit the **Museum of Indian Arts and Culture** and the **Wheelright Museum of the American Indian**. Our day ends with a group dinner.

DAY 4: FRIDAY, AUGUST 14

Friday is a full day of immersion in the Santa Fe Indian Market! We'll enjoy a later start this morning, beginning our day with a visit to the **Santa Fe Indian Market** Best in Show event and Luncheon, followed by the Sneak Peek. A studio visit in downtown Santa Fe will round out our Friday as a group. The evening is yours to enjoy the hotel or dinner downtown!

DAY 5: SATURDAY, AUGUST 15

Our final day in Santa Fe begins with a special visit to the **IAIA Museum of Contemporary Native Arts**. On our way to lunch, we will visit the famed **Loretto Chapel Museum**. Following our group lunch, we will explore the weekly **Santa Fe Artist's Market** located in the Railyard Arts Market. After a stop or two at local galleries, we'll head back to the hotel. Our evening concludes with a farewell dinner.

DAY 6: SUNDAY, AUGUST 16

Departures at leisure throughout the day or extend your stay to explore more of Santa Fe's vibrant art and cultural scene.
